



PERMANENT MAKE UP FAQ

DOES IT LOOK NATURAL?

Very natural, your features will look more defined. Your friend will never point out the difference unless you told them.

WILL IT FADE?

A color stabilization period occurs during the first 2 weeks. In 3 to 7 days the epidermal (outer) layer of skin will gradually peel or flake off. As the new layer regenerates, allowing a 10 to 15% fade during this time. Over time the color will soften.

HOW LONG WILL IT LAST?

This varies with each individual person. Though, the usual duration is between 1 to 5 years.

IS THERE CHANCE OF INFECTION?

Safety is our priority! We have highly trained & certified permanent make up artists.

WHAT IS THE HEALING PERIOD LIKE?

On the second day, after the procedure, a light crust will form. After this thin crust flakes off it is common for the color to lighten 10-15%. It will take between 4 to 7 days for the procedure to heal.

WILL THERE BE ANY SWELLING?

There may be a small amount of redness & swelling around the treated area. This will be gone in 6 to 12 hours after a Brow procedure, 24 to 48 hours after a Eyeliner or Lip color procedure. Benadryl (a non prescription antihistamine allergy medicine) will help reduce the swelling. This is recommended especially for any Eyeliner or Lip color procedures.
